Cookie Policy for AME Group Ltd

These are the terms and conditions that apply to the relationship between AME Group Limited and the Client in connection with the provision of the Design and / or Prototyping Services. The purpose is to regulate the relationship between the Client and AME Group and to ensure that the Client understands what it can expect from AME Group, and what AME Group is expected to do.

What Are Cookies

As is common practice with nearly all professional websites, this site uses Cookies, which are tiny files that are downloaded to your computer to improve your experience. This policy describes what information they gather, how we use it and why we sometimes need to store these Cookies. We will also share how you can prevent these Cookies from being stored, however this may downgrade or 'break' certain elements of the site's functionality.

How We Use Cookies

We use Cookies for a variety of reasons detailed below. Unfortunately, in most cases there are no industry standard options for disabling Cookies without completely disabling the functionality and features they add to this site. It is recommended that you leave on all Cookies if you are not sure whether you need them or not as they may be required to provide a service that you use.

Disabling Cookies

You can prevent the setting of Cookies by adjusting the settings on your browser (see your browser Help for how to do this). Please be aware that disabling Cookies will affect the functionality of this and many other websites that you visit. Disabling Cookies will usually result in certain functionality and features of the site being disabled. Therefore, it is recommended that you do not disable Cookies.

The Cookies We Use

We use a combination of Cookies on this website in order to monitor visitor usage levels, to help improve site performance and to enhance your user experience. This includes both session Cookies (which expire once you close your web browser) and persistent Cookies (which stay on your computer until you delete them).

Third Party Cookies

In some special cases we also use Cookies provided by trusted third parties.

This site uses Google Analytics, which is one of the most widespread and trusted analytics solutions on the web, for helping us to understand how you use the site and ways that we can improve your experience. These Cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the site and the pages that you visit, so we can continue to produce engaging content.

Third party analytics are used to track and measure usage of this site so that we can continue to produce engaging content.

From time to time we test new features and make subtle changes to the way that the site is delivered. When we are still testing new features, these Cookies may be used to ensure that you receive a consistent experience whilst on the site, whilst also ensuring we understand which optimisations our users appreciate the most.
